Minneapolis Hosts 41st Annual Meeting in July 2001

The 41st Annual Meeting of the Aquatic Plant Management Society will be held July 15-18, 2001 at the Marriott City Center in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Minneapolis has an average daily high temperature of 83°F in July. But if the weather doesn't cooperate, the Marriott City Center is connected to a glass-enclosed, climate-controlled skyway system. This system spans 60 city blocks and connects you to over 275 restaurants and bars, over 400 retail stores and shops, and many historic and cultural attractions.

The Local Arrangements Committee is busy making final arrangements for our meeting functions, including several special events. We'll get things started with the President's Reception on Sunday evening. This event is an excellent time to visit with old friends and to meet new friends. On Monday, while delegates are listening to the interesting presentations in the meeting sessions, their spouse and/or guests will be enjoying a day touring various attractions in the Twin Cities area. The APMS Awards Luncheon will be held on Tuesday and will feature the presentation of the student paper contest. And to bring it all to an end, we'll take a riverboat dinner cruise on the Upper Mississippi River on Wednesday evening. The cruise will feature the Scholastic Endowment Raffle and Grand Prize. These special events are free to all registered delegates, guests, and student paper competition participants. Non-registered guests and regular students can purchase tickets for these special events at the registration desk.

To make your hotel reservation, call the Marriott City Center directly at 612-349-4000 or Marriott Reservations at 800-228-9290 (in the US and Canada) on or before June 25, 2001. Be sure to mention that you are part of the Aquatic Plant Management Society. Special guest room rates are \$110.00 single or double, \$120.00 triple, and \$130.00 quad occupancy per night plus applicable taxes, currently 12%. All reservations must be accompanied by a first night room deposit or guaranteed with a major credit card. The Marriott City Center will not hold any reservation unless secured by one of the above methods.



The meeting registration fees are \$150.00 for delegates and \$65.00 for guests (spouse, partner, child over 12 years of age), if received before June 30, 2001. After this date, registration fees at the door will be \$175.00 for delegates and \$80.00 for guests. ATTENTION STUDENTS APMS Student Paper Contest 2001

Since 1975, the Aquatic Plant Management Society has conducted a student paper contest in conjunction with its annual meeting. The objectives of the contest are:

- 1) to encourage student participation in the Society affairs;
- 2) to provide students with the opportunity to gain experience in preparing and presenting scientific papers; and
- to recognize outstanding achievements by student members of the Society.

All contest entrants receive free meeting registration, free accommodations (based on double occupancy), book prizes, and certificates (suitable for framing). Cash awards are granted to first through fourth place winners.

Graduate and advanced undergraduate students who have had the opportunity to conduct independent research are encouraged to present their findings in the 2001 contest. Papers presented in the contest should be the results of the student's original research and should contain information not previously presented at an APMS meeting.

Sign up now! Student entrants should submit a title and abstract using a copy of the enclosed form on Page 3. Also, if you are submitting a paper, please go ahead and pre-register. Just complete the Page 4 pre-registration form and mail to the APMS address indicated on the form. Remember, only oral presentations will be accepted for the contest. Eligible applicants must be enrolled as full time undergraduate or graduate students in an accredited college or university in the United States. Course work or research in an area related to the biology, ecology or management of aquatic plants in the southeast is also required.

Applications must be received no later than

May 1, 2001

and will be evaluated on the basis of relevant test scores (ACT, SAT, GRE, etc.), high school and/or college grades, quality and relevance of course work or research, a proposed budget, information obtained from references, and other related considerations.

Other factors being equal, preference will be given to applicants enrolled in southeastern and South Carolina academic institutions.

The successful applicant may be requested to present an oral report on research activities at the annual meeting of the Society.


